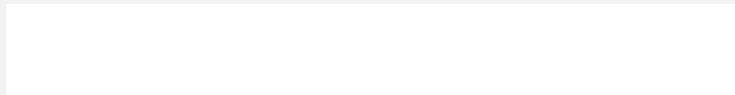

Des Moines Area Community College put years of innovation on display this week.

Some of us can remember what the first computer looked like or rotary telephones, but if your memory is spotty one can come refresh it at DMACC.

"This is a learning exhibition that we started building about 5 years ago," said Dr. Anthony Paustian, Provost of DMACC's West Campus.

Five years and about \$70,000 later, DMACC's west campus has been transformed into a flashback of telecommunications and computer history.

"Yea it is something that you don't get to see all the time different colleges even other campuses don't have this is something unique to west campus," said Meredith Campbell of the Student Activities Council.

Each room features a great American innovator and gives information about their contributions. The hallway is littered with artifacts that display the progression of technology. Most of the exhibits were donated to the college or bought with money raised by students.

"The environment here is so much different so unique than most college campuses around the country," Paustian said.
